



CASE STUDY – WASHINGTON D.C. 2016 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION

BACKGROUND

For the 2016 General Election, the District of Columbia implemented Vote4DC, powered by Votem's ABVote platform to process online voter registration and request absentee ballots via both secure mobile apps and the Vote4DC website. The development of this application was sponsored by the Federal Voting Assistance Program (FVAP) meant to facilitate the experience of military and overseas voters in compliance with the FVAP guidelines and of electors with disabilities in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.



IMPACT

Supporting the District of Columbia's 448,718 registered Voters, Votem's platform allowed voters of all ages – quite literally from citizens under 18 to 97 – to take part in DC's election from the majority of US States and from across the globe with access from over 50 countries. By partnering with Votem to supply DC voters an accessible and convenient election experience, DC earned accolades from voters.
