


CASE STUDY – MONTANA 2016 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION

BACKGROUND

For the 2016 General Election, the State of Montana implemented Votem's Electronic Absentee System (EAS) and the Electronic Ballot Request System (EBRS) to facilitate absentee requests and absentee ballot delivery serving military and overseas voters in compliance with the Federal Voting Assistance Program and electors with disabilities in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.



IMPACT

Supporting Montana's 674,264 registered voters, Votem's platform allowed eligible Montana citizens to register to vote online, to request, mark and complete an online ballot, and to submit the completed ballot back to the State of Montana with electronic affirmation via mail, fax, or email.


Votem's accessible site worked with virtually all devices and has been reviewed and endorsed by the National Federation for the Blind (NFB).

Votem's EAS platform promoted participation from across the globe with access from the majority of US States and over 50 countries from South Africa, to Israel, to our Canadian neighbors to the north allowing thousands of UOCAVA (Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act) voters to partake in the democratic process. Voters of all ages – quite literally from voters who just turned 18 to those in their late 80's – took part in this election.

Through multi-geographic server redundancy, Votem deployed its platform 24x7 ensuring the best scaling, security, and stability for providing ballot access and administrative capabilities over the course of the election.
